'Hither hath the LORD helped us'

In 2020 we reached the milestone of the 30th year of our Distribution Fund. We have copies of all the Annual Reports going back all these years, and with much thanksgiving, we record the Lord's goodness. In this report we look back not only to last year, but have glimpses of those that have gone before, and can say by God's grace, 'For all things come of thee, and of thine own have we given thee'. Our main focus throughout has been to supply Bibles to Schools, missionaries and others at home and abroad.

From very small beginnings in the UK, with a view to giving Bibles, we offered Children's books to Primary schools. This later established the regular giving of School Leaver's Bibles in a number of Primary schools each vear. Thankfully, in the late 1900's the King James Bible and Pilgrim's Progress were both listed for study as English Classics in the national curriculum. We took advantage of this, which led in 1996 alone to 1,022 Bibles and 1,101 Pilgrim's Progress being given to Secondary schools. This continued for the next few years, together with the giving of a large number of Creation books.

In 2002 with the TBS Special edition of a Queen's Golden Jubilee Bible we were able to gift over 2,000 Bibles to children and teachers in local schools. Then in 2011 we had the prospect of supplying as many Bibles as possible to commemorate the 400th anniversary year of the King James Bible, mainly to our Secondary schools, but then again, the following year in 2012, we were heartened with the Queen's Diamond Jubilee Bible, when almost 5,000 Bibles were given away in our schools. These give a few UK highlights from the earlier years.


Our overseas distribution commenced by sending Russian Bibles & other publications to Russia and the Ukraine. In the 1900's we also commenced supporting the Trinitarian Bible Society, sending to individuals requesting Bibles. In the late 1900's we were receiving about 2,000 requests a year. Since then, we have sent to many countries in all continents across the world. Requests for larger numbers of Bibles have also been met, and in particular consignments have been sent to Ghana each year. This also led us to support new church building projects in the south of Ghana, and through our Distribution Fund the Savannah Education Trust was set up in the north, where there are now nine schools.

'Having therefore obtained help of God, we continue to this day'.

UK Distribution - Secondary Schools

There are a number highlights looking back over the years, particularly being able to offer the King James Bible and Pilgrim's Progress, listed for the study of English in the 1990's, but we also gave many hundreds of the book 'The Amazing Story of Creation' by D T Gish (large hardback).

A letter received at that time from a Secondary School in Woking, said "I would like to thank you indeed for the 30 copies of The Amazing Story of Creation, this valuable resource for our Religious Studies Dept. They will certainly be put to good use and I am pleased how Christian Creationism is put forward in an exciting and challenging way. It will be a great help as we seek to explore some of the myths, misconceptions and questions students have about the whole area of 'Creation and Evolution' and hopefully it will help pupils to re-think the notion that it's a simple case of Christianity versus science".

'History of the Bible' **lectures**

Like the Jubilee Bible earlier, the TBS published a Special Bible edition for the 400th anniversary of the King James Bible in 2011, Since then our Pastor Stephen Hyde has been giving illustrated talks on the 'History of the Bible' in our Secondary Schools each year. Each student is offered a Bible and many copies of God's Word have been placed directly into the hands of Secondary School children. In 2011 alone, lectures were given in four schools and 1,010 Bibles were given to students that year. Sadly, in recent years this has reduced to just one school, the Reigate School, when over 250 students have gladly received Bibles. We were thankful these talks were welcomed again in 2020, but regretfully, due to the Coronavirus none of the lessons could take place.

In the past 30 years (over three 10-year periods), we have circulated all Primary Schools in a large area of Surrey, Kent and Sussex, also in the London Metropolitan area south of the Thames. Large quantities of Bibles and other books have been distributed to the schools over the years, mainly for class use, but one or two schools each year have regularly requested School Leaver's Bibles to present at the end of the summer term.

In 2005 we sent samples to 117 schools in the London metropolitan area and delivered to 64 schools. New school orders included: 645 Bibles and 7,645 Children's books besides Ten Commandment cards, posters and bookmarks. In 2020, notwithstanding the Coronavirus, we were thankful to be able to distribute 770 School Leaver's Bibles with Children's Books and Ten Commandment bookmarks to Primary Schools.

Queen's Diamond Jubilee Bibles in 2012

In addition to our regular School Leaver's Bibles in 2012 we offered the Diamond Jubilee Bibles to 42 local Primary schools and 21 responded with requests for **4,222** Bibles. Teachers and some parents wanted them for other members of their families. Pastor Stephen Hyde also gave talks and presented Bibles at five of these schools.

If the Lord permit, we hope the TBS will be able to publish a **Platinum Special Edition in 2022**, to offer to our schools.

AD Booklet - 1999

In 1999 the 'AD' booklet was published. The purpose of the booklet was to show how Christianity has transformed and shaped our lives over 2000 years: how it shaped our language and laws and led the way in science, education and in vital social and health reforms. Sending 30 sample copies to all local schools offering to supply a copy to all pupils, this offer was welcomed by the schools and we distributed a total of 11,228 of booklets.

Mayflower Old & NT Teachers Manuals.

In 2014 we offered Primary Schools the Mayflower Old & New Testament Teachers Manuals. These were taken up by 44 schools that year, which also ordered 866 Bibles and 1,036 Children's books. More manuals were taken in subsequent years.

- Man said the first Stall he'd seen 'all for Jesus'




Calendar Distribution

In 2020 the TBS Words of Life calendars were distributed in December by Royal Mail (Door to Door) due to the Coronavirus. The calendars were overprinted with the Chapel details, and we pray that these may bear fruit.

In 2011 we distributed overprint calendars to local homes with a pastoral letter and the booklet 'Vanity of Vanities' with our own Bible Bookmark. Other years we have given Gospels and other booklets.

Preparing calendars for distribution in December 2007

In 2005 we delivered 3000 calendars with Luke's Gospel and a Free-Post order form offering free Bibles, Children's books and the 'Life Story' Creation DVD. From this we had requests for 15 Bibles 16 Children's books and 7 DVDs

In 2009 following the distribution of calendars a local resident expressed an interest in translating 'Bible Doctrines' into the Urdu language. Translation work was completed in 2011 and 6,000 copies were printed. The Gospel Standard Trust were pleased to support this project resulting in a total of 12,000 copies being printed for distribution in the five provinces of Pakistan. The Gospel Standard Trust gave a further £1,000 in 2013 towards the cost of another print run. As a consequence of this Urdu translation Pastor Stephen Hyde was also invited to preach at a conference in Lahore. This was held at the pastor's church who was involved in the translation and printing. Hope Chapel helped with funds for the rebuilding of this church after it was demolished by Islamic extremists.




Setting out for our Calendar Distribution in 2009

Scripture Railway Posters

In recent years, through the Trinitarian Bible Society, we have sponsored the display of large Railway Scripture Posters at Redhill station. On the main Brighton to London line, these posters have been seen by many thousands of travellers and commuters. Sadly, earlier in the year the Train Operators recategorized the TBS posters as Religious Advertising, and as such displays of the poster were no longer permitted. Following legal advice TBS are challenging this ruling and the outcome is still awaited.

TBS received a complaint in September 2019
Poster text > 'At the name of Jesus every knee should bow'. The complainant felt it was inappropriate and personally felt affronted by it, asking the TBS to remove it. The TBS responded saying, they were sorry it was felt inappropriate and that he was affronted by it, but their purpose was that the public display of the Scriptures should be for the glory of God and the salvation of sinners, which Christians believe to be noble ends. Adding, indeed, many Christians find a great proportion of public posters and adverts offensive and an affront to Christian values.

Creation Magazine Subscriptions

We continue to give annual subscriptions of the 'Creation' magazine to Secondary Schools, UK Prisons and local Doctors and Dentists surgeries.

In 2007 we first offered 140 Prison and Young Offenders Centres annual subscriptions for the Creation Magazine, and then in 2010 this was followed up with an offer of the 'Life Story' Creation DVD and TBS Bibles in various languages. Requests were received for the Scriptures in Arabic, Armenian, Catalan, Dutch, Persian Farsi (Iran), German, Greek, Hebrew, Hungarian, Italian. Lithuanian, Ndebele (Zimbabwe). Nepali. Polish. Portuguese. Russian, Tamil, Turkish, Ukrainian & Welsh.

Creation 'Life Story' DVD

In 2006 we sent the 'Life Story' Creation DVDs to all Christian Union branches in our universities. With the DVDs we sent two different posters. One to offer free DVDs and the other to advertise a venue for the Christian Union to show the DVD and debate Creation and Evolution. A designated website www.lifestory.biz was set up for students to apply for a copy and we had 19 requests. We were very thankful too to receive a request for more posters to advertise a showing of the DVD at one of the universities.

Worldwide Distribution

In the 1990's the Trinitarian Bible Society received well over 10,000 letters each year requesting Bibles. Since the 1990's we have been pleased to assist the TBS with these requests and have sent many thousands of Bibles in response to individuals from countries across the world. We continue to do so in various languages, although the number of requests now are very much lower than in early years.

Russian & Ukraine Scriptures

Through the years we have sent Russian Bibles, New Testaments and Gospels to Russia and Ukraine to longstanding contacts that friends have kept in touch with, sending calendars, some to remote parts, for well over 20 years.

Thank-you letter was received in 2011:

"Our heartfelt thanks for 2 parcels with literature. God bless you. Please pray that more people may start to believe in God" The Pirkov family.

Bible Doctrines sent with Bibles

In the 1990's we sent 'Bible Doctrines' by Mr Ramsbottom, with the TBS Bibles. In March 2013 we received an email from South Africa referring to a Bible and Bible Doctrines we had sent 20 years before. The email requested a further copy of Bible Doctrines as the original had been lent to a friend and never returned. He says "when you sent me these books you had really planted a strong seed in my life when I was still young - I am now 35, and I love the Lord." We sent four further copies.

'My word... shall not return unto me void'.

Letter from Mumbai India

Dharmendra originally wrote in 2010 saying that he had received a Bible from us 10 years ago. He told us that he had been blessed by reading this Bible and it had been the means of his conversion. We later sent him Bible Doctrines and Matthew Henry's commentary. In 2013 he wrote again saying "The book Bible Doctrines is very helpful to explain God's love to the people. Please pray for me. God has given me a burden to serve village children in many remote villages where there are no schools."

Ghana Support

For 20 years we have had a special relationship with our friends in Ghana. Since the early years we have sent a consignment of several hundred Bibles for distribution each year at the local Baptist Believers Conference held at the end of December. The conference is attended by 1000 to 2000 people and we have been so thankful for the generous support over the years of the TBS who have sent many thousands of Bibles and Scriptures for distribution at this annual conference. The Trinitarian Bible Society shipment in recent years has included a large number of French Golden Thoughts calendars for distribution in neighbouring Burkina Faso, and some for Togo and the Ivory Coast.

Savannah Education Trust - Schools

We were very pleased to support the Savannah Education Trust again in 2020 by sending 500 Bibles for class use in the Savannah schools: 320 Bibles for their eight Primary schools and 180 Bibles for their six Secondary schools.

In recent years we have also sent a large number of the Miracle Parable Series of Children's books and more recently the new Faithful Footsteps series of children's books by Mr Ramsbottom, all of which are now in the schools and we hope to send more as new schools open.
